

George B. Todd Grant Guidelines

Chesapeake College has been given authorization by the Mid-Shore Community Foundation to work with Dorchester County Public Schools to implement the \$25,000 George B. Todd Dual Enrollment Grant each year (fall and spring semesters only.) This grant has been made possible by the generosity of George B. Todd to greatly expand early access to college education to Dorchester County high school students and help these students accelerate attainment of their educational and career goals.

In addition to being a resident of Dorchester County, the student must meet the following guidelines for grant consideration:

- ❖ Attend Cambridge-South Dorchester High School or North Dorchester High School
- ❖ Meet the eligibility requirements for the Dual Enrollment Program
- ❖ All students who have taken less than four college courses must have a high school cum GPA of **2.75**.
- ❖ All students who have taken four or more college courses must have a high school cum GPA of **2.75** AND a college GPA of **2.75**.
- ❖ Submit a grant application each semester to be considered for funding.
- ❖ Priority will be given to students who demonstrate financial need.

Note: Eligible students must be registered for college courses to be considered for a grant. If you decide to be put on a wait list to get a course (rather than registering for a course with openings), you may be in jeopardy of not receiving a grant.

George B. Todd grant applications received by **June 1st** for Fall Semester and by **December 14th** for the Spring Semester will be given first consideration and will be based on the availability of funds.
